

PRIVACY BAMBOO

Have you considered bamboo as a hedge? You Should!

UNIQUE PROPERTIES FOR CREATING PRIVACY

- Once an individual bamboo culm (cane) is cut, it will not grow any taller but will add branches and leaves from the top down.
- In the winter, roots will grow but new shoots will not appear until spring.
- Maintenance is often less than traditional hedges and only necessary in spring and summer when the bamboo is actively growing and putting out new shoots.
- Trimming less often facilitates natural growth and a more tropical look.



GRACEFUL BAMBOO

Bambusa textilis gracilis
Mature height 25', 1.25" cane caliper Zone 8b
Tight clumping, makes a dense green hedge



ASIAN LEMON BAMBOO

Bambusa eutuldoides 'Viridivittata'
Mature height 35', 2.5" cane caliper Zone 8b
Canary yellow canes with green stripes



MALAY VARIEGATED BAMBOO

Bambusa glaucophylla variegated
Mature height 12', 3/4" cane caliper Zone 9b
Makes a beautiful variegated hedge



SEABREEZE BAMBOO

Bambusa malingensis
Mature height 35', 2" cane caliper Zone 9a
More wind & salt tolerant than most other varieties



FERNLEAF BAMBOO

Bambusa multiplex
Non-invasive clumping bamboo Zone 8b
Mature height 16', 1/2" cane caliper, Foliage easy to shape
